The Pentecost Novena was decreed by Pope Leo XIII on May 9, 1897, calling on the whole Church to pray for a greater outpouring of the Holy Spirit as promised by Jesus Christ. This year, the Cathedral of Christ the King will host the first diocesan Pentecost Novena, referred to as “**Nine Days of Power**” for personal, parish, and diocesan spiritual renewal.

Due to the Coronavirus pandemic, this will be a virtual event only and will be live-streamed each evening.
